Description of Research and Scholarly or Creative Objectives

My doctoral dissertation focused on examining the barriers and facilitators to graduate degree attainment among Filipino American nurses. My research findings illuminated how Philippine-trained and U.S. born and trained Filipino American nurses constructed their careers within the geopolitical landscape between the U.S. and the Philippines that steered them to bedside nursing in intensive care units. These nurses had strong cultural influences that steered them away from pursuing advanced practice degrees, academic and research careers, and non-acute primary care specialties such as women's health. As a Filipino American nurse researcher with two decades of clinical experience as a women's health nurse practitioner, I set forth two goals: 1) advance rigorous research that is relevant to the health of Filipino women across the lifespan; 2) mentor a pipeline of Filipino American clinicians and researchers who will strategically address health disparities and promote health equity issues within the Filipino/a/x American community.
